



Fraudulent Text Message Notice

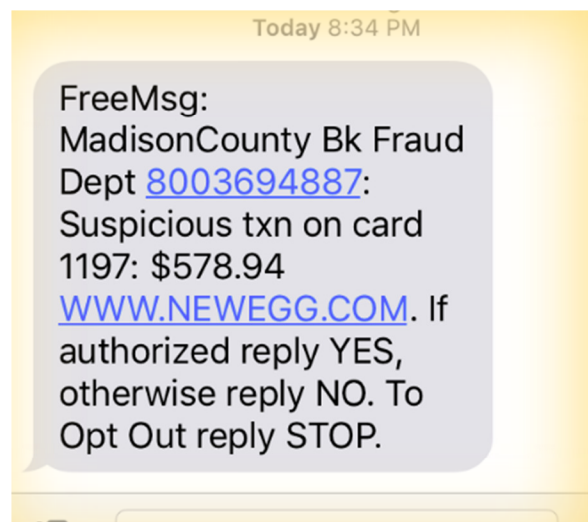
Madison County Bank is aware of a fake text message in circulation that indicates a potential fraudulent transaction may have occurred on your debit card and the message requests for you to take action to resolve the situation.

This message did not come from Madison County Bank and should be treated as a phishing attempt to compromise your private information. This message should be deleted immediately and under no circumstances should you respond to the message or click on any of the links provided. The message is an attempt by someone to illegally induce you to provide them with your bank account information.

If you have received this message and used the links provided, please contact the bank immediately!

Madison County Bank does use a Fraud Monitoring Service that monitors your debit card 24x7 for fraudulent transactions. However, we do not use text messages or email as a means to notify you in the event of suspicious activity on your debit card.
